Thank you to parents for your support of our pupils and our school and hope to see many of you at upcoming events over the next few months. – Mrs Burns


Parent Meetings

Times Tables Meetings for Year 3 & 4 Parents

Year 4 children in all schools, take the Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) in June. The purpose of this check, is to ensure that their times tables knowledge is at the expected level. This is an online test where the pupil is asked 25 questions on times tables 2 to 12.
