#### **Strike Action**

Following recent ballots by teacher unions, the National Education Union (NEU) intend to carry out industrial action during February and March. The following dates may affect schools in Carlisle are –

Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> February Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> March Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> February Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March

Partial or full closure on these dates may be an option for Upperby Primary School, but as yet this is not clear. However, I wanted to let you know as soon as possible, as you may need to consider alternative childcare arrangements on these dates.

Whilst as a school we regret any inconvenience this may cause, we must respect that members of any professional association / union have the right to take this action following a legal ballot.

I have several meetings planned in the next few days to gain clarity on the situation. Following this, I aim to give parents a weeks' notice, regarding the 1<sup>st</sup> February. Thank you for your understanding with this matter.
